During the assessment the schools head teacher Aimee Christian shared that during a recent Ofsted inspection they were asked about what career related learning happens in school. This quotation was included in the final Ofsted report.

"Leaders place a strong focus on early careers education. Local and national employers, including those in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics industries, inspire pupils to be ambitious in thinking about their future careers. For example, an aquarist from 'The Deep' presented a day in the life session. Similarly, teachers have linked visits to a major film studio with careers in this industry."

This highlights the growing prominence and recognition of careers delivery in primary schools at the highest level. Well done to all the staff and learners at Roo's, a well deserved acknowledgement of Roo's successful incorporation of careers in the curriculum.

Posters and notice boards promoting STEM related work
