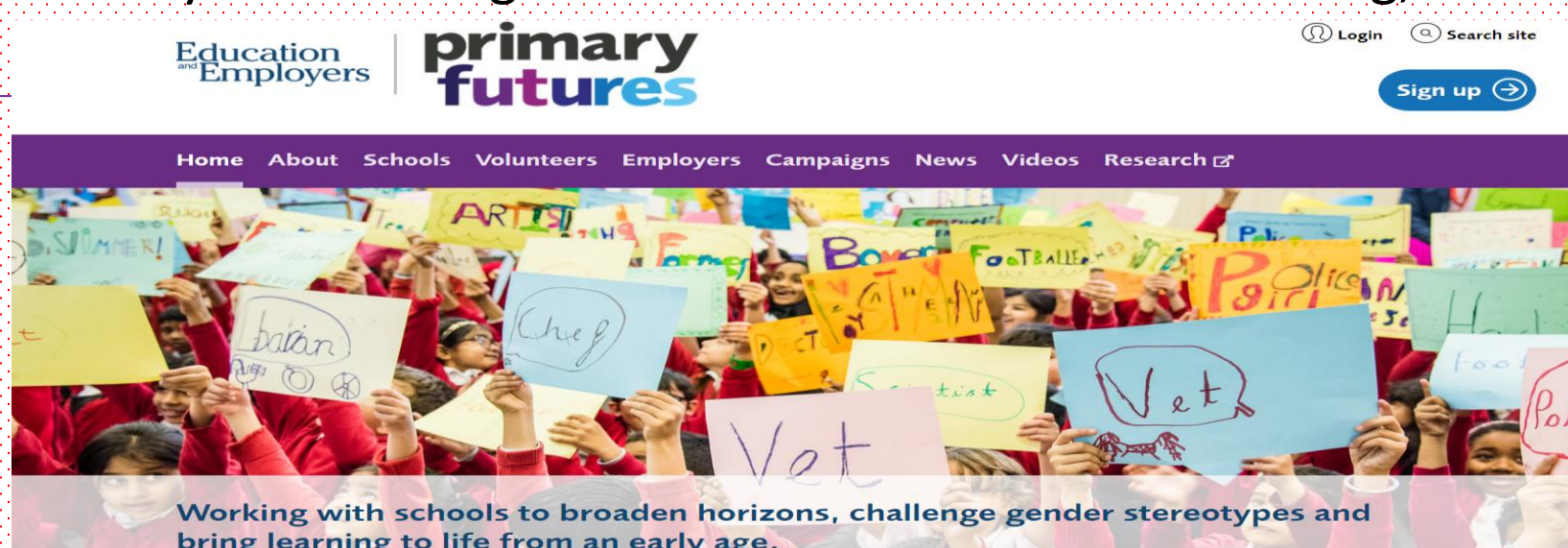

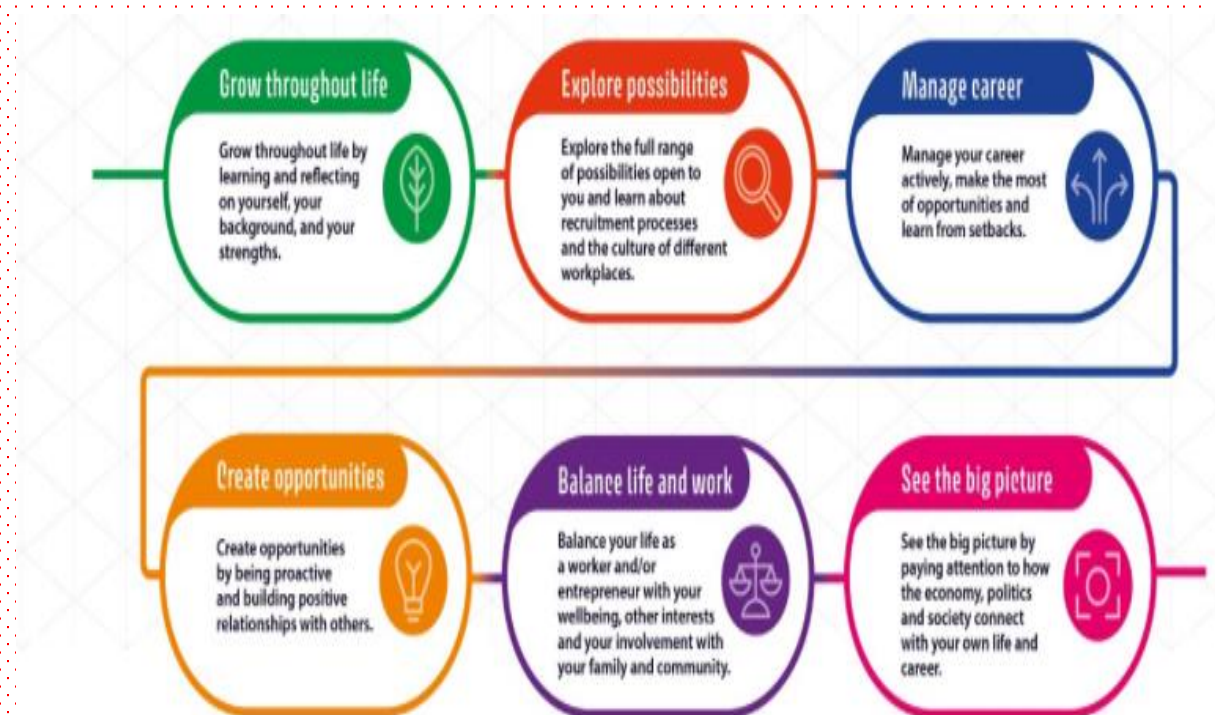
This year we're exploring the theme of money management and financial inclusion.
